



Exciting news! Mandeville High is now offering another way to earn college credit through CLEP testing. This year we will be offering the following CLEP tests:

With a passing score on one CLEP exam, you could earn three or more college credits at more than 2,900 U.S. colleges and universities. Here is how CLEP testing works:

- Students take CLEP exams on a computer at Mandeville High.
- CLEP exams contain multiple-choice questions.
- CLEP exams take about 90–120 minutes to complete, depending on the exam subject.
- Students receive their CLEP exam scores immediately after completing the exam (except for College Composition).
- More than 2,900 U.S. colleges and universities grant credit for CLEP.
- The cost for testing is \$89 and will be paid online

To find more information on college credits that can be earned with colleges or universities you are interested in simply follow the steps below:

- Log on to college board website at www.collegeboard.org
- Click on the CLEP Tab
- Search Institution Policies in the search engine
- Click on Search Institution Policies Tab
- Type in your college or university of interest and search by test

The College Board will issue a refund for CLEP exams up to seven days from the date of purchase with the exception of redeemed tests.
