

DUAL ENROLLMENT

2019 / 2020

All students will be moved to the dual enrollment section of a course after completion of the application.

Students must request transcripts for college credit earned through dual enrollment directly from the college in which the course was taken.

St. Tammany Parish School Board will pay for 3 hours of dual enrollment credit for the 2019/2020 school year.

ENGLISH DUAL ENROLLEMENT COURSES

ENGLISH IV HONORS – SOUTHEASTERN UNIVERSITY

- 1) Students can earn up to 6 hours of college credit: 3 hours in the fall (English 101 Freshman Composition) and 3 hours in the spring (English 102 Critical Reading and Writing). Students must turn in application and payment in both the fall and spring semesters.
- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 11th or 12th grade.
 - b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course.
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).
 - d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required English score of 18 but does not meet the Math score of 19, the student can still dual enroll in English IV while continuing to take a Math course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$225 per 3-credit hours. Checks are made payable to MHS. Please note that tuition is NOT refundable should a student withdraw from a course.
- 4) ACT or Pre-Act score report and the TOPS University Dual Enrollment form must be turned in with all applications. Student transcript will be printed by dual enrollment coordinator.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES

FRENCH II – LOUISIANA TECH UNIVERSITY

- 1) Students can earn up to 6 hours of college credit: 3 hours in the fall (French 101 Elementary French) and 3 hours in the spring (French 102 Elementary French). Students must turn in application and payment in both the fall and spring semesters.
- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 10th, 11th or 12th grade.
 - b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).
 - d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required English score of 18 but does not meet the Math score of 19, the student can still dual enroll in French II while continuing to take a Math course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$150 per 3-credit hours and a once a year \$20 application fee. Checks are made payable to Louisiana Tech University. The application fee and tuition payment can be combined on one check. If students are taking more than one dual enrollment course through Louisiana Tech, only one application fee is required. Please note that tuition is NOT refundable should a student withdraw from a course.
- 4) Applications must be completed on online (please see link below). Once the application has completed online, please print a copy and sign in all appropriate places. Only applications completed online and signed will be accepted.

FRENCH III – LOUISIANA TECH UNIVERSITY

- 1) Students can earn up to 6 hours of college credit: 3 hours in the fall (French 201 Intermediate French) and 3 hours in the spring (French 202 Intermediate French). Students must turn in application and payment in both the fall and spring semesters.
- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade.
 - b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).

- d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required English score of 18 but does not meet the Math score of 19, the student can still dual enroll in French III while continuing to take a Math course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$150 per 3-credit hours and a \$20 application fee. Checks are made payable to Louisiana Tech University. The application fee and tuition payment can be combined on one check. If students are taking more than one dual enrollment course through Louisiana Tech, only one application fee is required. Please note that tuition is NOT refundable should a student withdraw from a course.

- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade.
 - b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course.
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).
 - d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required English score of 18 but does not meet the Math score of 19, the student can still dual enroll in Spanish II while continuing to take a Math course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$150 per 3-credit hours and a \$20 application fee. Checks are made payable to Louisiana Tech University. The application fee and tuition payment can be combined on one check. - 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade.
 - b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course.
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).
 - d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required English score of 18 but does not meet the Math score of 19, the student can still dual enroll in Spanish III while continuing to take a Math course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.

MATH DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES

ALGEBRA III HONORS – SOUTHEASTERN LOUISIANA UNIVERSITY

- 1) Students can earn up to 3 hours of college credit (Math 161 College Algebra) for the year.
- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 11th or 12th grade.
 - b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).

- d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required Math score of 19 but does not meet the English score of 18, the student can still dual enroll in Algebra III while continuing to take an English course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$225 per 3-credit hours. Checks are made payable to MHS. Please note that tuition is NOT refundable should a student withdraw from a course.
 - 4) ACT or Pre-Act score report and the TOPS University Dual Enrollment form must be turned in with all applications. Student transcript will be printed by dual enrollment coordinator.

CALCULUS HONORS – SOUTHEASTERN LOUISIANA UNIVERSITY

- 1) Students can earn up to 3 hours of college credit (Math 163 Applied Calculus) for the year.
- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must have 3 hours of Math 161 College Algebra credit.
 - b. Students must be in 11th or 12th grade.
 - c. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course
 - d. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).
 - e. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required Math score of 19 but does not meet the English score of 18, the student can still dual enroll in Calculus while continuing to take an English course to improve the deficiency.
 - f. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$225 per 3-credit hours. Checks are made payable to MHS. Please note that tuition is NOT refundable should a student withdraw from a course.
- 4) ACT or Pre-Act score report and the TOPS University Dual Enrollment form must be turned in with all applications. Student transcript will be printed by dual enrollment coordinator.

PRE-CALCULUS GIFTED – LOUISIANA TECH UNIVERSITY

- 1) Students can earn up to 6 hours of college credit: 3 hours in the fall (Math 101 College Algebra) and 3 hours in the spring (Math 112 Trigonometry). Students must turn in application and payment in both the fall and spring semesters.
- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade.
 - b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course.
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).

- d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required Math score of 19 but does not meet the English score of 18, the student can still dual enroll in Pre-Calculus while continuing to take an English course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$150 per 3-credit hours and a \$20 application fee. Checks are made payable to Louisiana Tech University. The application fee and tuition payment can be combined on one check. If students are taking more than one dual enrollment course through Louisiana Tech, only one application fee is required. PRE-CALCULUS HONORS – SOUTHEASTERN LOUISIANA UNIVERSITY

- 1) Students can earn up to 6 hours of college credit: 3 hours in the fall (Math 161 College Algebra) and 3 hours in the spring (Math 162 Plane Trigonometry). Students must turn in application and payment in both the fall and spring semesters).
- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 11th or 12th grade.
 - b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).
 - d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required Math score of 19 but does not meet the English score of 18, the student can still dual enroll in Pre-Calculus while continuing to take an English course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$225 per 3-credit hours. Checks are made payable to MHS. Please note that tuition is NOT refundable should a student withdraw from a course.

PROBABILITY & STATISTICS HONORS – SOUTHEASTERN LOUISIANA UNIVERSITY

- 1) Students can earn up to 3 hours of college credit (Math 241 Elementary Statistics) for the year.

- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must have 3 hours of Math 161 College Algebra credit.
 - b. Students must be in 11th or 12th grade.
 - c. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course
 - d. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).
 - e. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required Math score of 19 but does not meet the English score of 18, the student can still dual enroll in Probability & Statistics while continuing to take an English course to improve the deficiency.
 - f. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$225 per 3-credit hours. Checks are made payable to MHS. Please note that tuition is NOT refundable should a student withdraw from a course.
- 4) ACT or Pre-Act score report and the TOPS University Dual Enrollment form must be turned in with all applications. Student transcript will be printed by dual enrollment coordinator.

SCIENCE DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES

BIOLOGY II HONORS – LOUISIANA TECH UNIVERSITY

- 1) Students can earn up to 3 hours of college credit (BISC 224 Essentials of Human Anatomy and Physiology for non-Biology majors) for the year.
- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade.
 - b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).
 - d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required Math score of 19 but does not meet the English score of 18, the student can still dual enroll in Biology II while continuing to take and English course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$150 per 3-credit hours and a once a year \$20 application fee. Checks are made payable to Louisiana Tech University. The application fee and tuition payment can be combined on one check. If students are taking more than one dual enrollment course through Louisiana Tech, only one application fee is required. Please note that tuition is NOT refundable should a student withdraw from a course.

- 1) Students can earn up to 3 hours of college credit (CHEM 101 General Chemistry I for non-science majors) for the year.
- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 11th or 12th grade.
 - b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).
 - d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required Math score of 19 but does not meet the English score of 18, the student can still dual enroll in Chemistry while continuing to take an English course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$225 per 3-credit hours. Checks are made payable to MHS. Please note that tuition is NOT refundable should a student withdraw from a course.

PSYCHOLOGY HONORS – LOUISIANA TECH UNIVERSITY

- 1) Students can earn up to 3 hours of college credit (PSYC 102 General Psychology) for the year.
- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade.
 - b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).

- d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required English score of 18 but does not meet the Math score of 19, the student can still dual enroll in Psychology while continuing to take a Math course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$150 per 3-credit hours and a once a year \$20 application fee. Checks are made payable to Louisiana Tech University. The application fee and tuition payment can be combined on one check. If students are taking more than one dual enrollment course through Louisiana Tech, only one application fee is required. Please note that tuition is NOT refundable should a student withdraw from a course.

U.S. HISTORY HONORS – SOUTHEASTERN LOUISIANA UNIVERSITY

- 1) Students can earn up to 3 hours of college credit (HIST 202 American History since 1877) for the year.
- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 11th or 12th grade.
 - b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).
 - d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required English score of 18 but does not meet the Math score of 19, the student can still dual enroll in U.S. History while continuing to take a Math course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$225 per 3-credit hours. Checks are made payable to MHS. Please note that tuition is NOT refundable should a student withdraw from a course.
- 4) ACT or Pre-Act score report and the TOPS University Dual Enrollment form must be turned in with all applications. Student transcript will be printed by dual enrollment coordinator.

WORLD HISTORY HONORS – SOUTHEASTERN LOUISIANA UNIVERSITY

- 1) Students can earn up to 3 hours of college credit (HIST 102 Western Civilization since 1500) for the year.
- 2) Eligibility
 - a. Students must be in 11th or 12th grade.

- b. Students must have an ACT or Pre-Act score prior to enrolling in the course
 - c. Students must have a composite score of at least a 19 with a minimum of an 18 on the English portion and a minimum of 19 in the Math portion (these scores are the same for the ACT and Pre-Act).
 - d. In Cases of a deficiency: If a student meets the required English score of 18 but does not meet the Math score of 19, the student can still dual enroll in World History while continuing to take a Math course to improve the deficiency.
 - e. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3) Cost: \$225 per 3-credit hours. Checks are made payable to MHS. Please note that tuition is NOT refundable should a student withdraw from a course.
