

Mandeville High - Information for New Students

NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION

- New student registration will be held on Tuesday, July 28 and Wednesday, July 29, 2020, from 9:00 A.M. – 12:00 noon. Registration will be held in the school gym. The gym is located to the left of the main entrance to the school.

NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

- New student orientation is tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, August 4, 2020. The event will start in the gym at 9:00 A.M. and will end at approximately 11:30 A.M.
- This event is for new students. No activities are planned for parents.
- Most new students will receive their schedules at the orientation and will have the opportunity to meet their teachers. Also the students will get to “run through” their schedule visiting their classrooms. At the end of the program students will have an opportunity to learn about the clubs offered at MHS.

SUPPLY LISTS

At the high school level a generic supply list is not available. On the first day of school students should bring a notebook or folder with paper and a writing utensil. Teachers will either give a handout with the supply information for their individual course or they will have the supply list written on the board.

BUS INFORMATION

Bus routes will be posted outside of the administration offices and on the school website. Usually we receive bus routes prior to New Student Registration. Students/Parents can look for their particular bus driver by looking at the routes and locating the specific street name or subdivision. A phone number for the bus driver will be located at the top of the route. Use the phone number to contact the individual driver and he/she will be able to give specific information about the pick-up time. UNIFORMS

Mandeville High does not require students to wear uniforms. Information for student dress can be found in the St. Tammany Parish Handbook available at <http://www.stpsb.org/DisciplineHandbook/DistrictHandbook.pdf>. Additional information regarding dress code from the MHS Student/Parent Handbook is listed below.

Policies regarding dress and grooming stress the importance of reducing distractions that inhibit learning and are addressed as an attempt to enhance the safe learning environment. Final interpretation of the dress code rests solely with the administration. The Principal maintains the right to determine extremes in styles of dress and grooming. Extremes in style and fit in student dress and extremes in style of grooming will not be permitted. Refer to the Handbook on Attendance, Discipline, and Student Records for additional information regarding dress code.

1. Students are not allowed to wear tank tops, muscle shirts, sleeveless t-shirts and plain white undershirts as outer garments.
2. All hats, caps, bandannas, stocking caps, etc. are not to be worn during regular school hours. Female students may wear a scarf, but it cannot cover all of the hair. Hoodies may not be worn inside of the school building.
3. Male students must be clean shaven and are prohibited from wearing goatees, pork chop sideburns, or beards of any type. Sideburns may be worn to the base of the earlobes.
4. Female students must wear tops that cover most of the top of the shoulders. Most tops with “straps” are not allowed as an outer garment and no top should allow under garments to be seen. Off-the-shoulder blouses/shirts are not allowed
5. Sheer, see through, or low cut shirts and blouses are not allowed.
6. Blouses and shirts must be long enough so that no skin may be seen between the pants/skirt and shirt. This rule includes any position including sitting.
7. Shorts, culottes, skirts and dresses should **clearly extend beyond fingertip length** when student is standing erect with his or her arms extended down or should not be more than 5” above the knee. **Due to the fact that “finger tip length” is somewhat nebulous students must wear shorts having at least a 7 inch inseam.** Athletic shorts must have at least a 7 inch inseam. “Yoga pants” may be worn, however the student must wear a shirt that is fingertip length which covers the full front side and backside. Shorts worn over “leggings” are subject to the same length requirements mentioned above.
8. The wearing of body piercing ornaments is limited to the ear. Larger “Gauge” earrings are an extreme in style and are not allowed. Male students may wear only “stud” type earrings. Students may not use Band-Aids or clear “place holders” to circumvent the piercing policy.
9. Pants must be secured at the waist at all times and may not reveal undergarments.
10. Pants containing excessive breaks, holes or rips will be considered an extreme in style and will not be allowed. This includes clothing purchased with breaks, holes or rips.
11. Pajamas and robes are not appropriate attire for school. Pants that have the appearance of pajama bottoms will be considered pajamas and are not appropriate. It is inappropriate to bring pillows and blankets to school.
12. Hair must be clean and not unusually colored. Unusually colored means any color other than a natural hair color (this includes almost all shades of red). Two color hair styles (including “natural” colors) will not be allowed. Students may have highlights, but should not color sections or portions of their hair. Students are not allowed to have multi-color weaves. Sculptured hair styles will not be permitted. Partially shaven hair is not allowed unless it is clearly uniform (flat top, crew cut, etc.). Mohawks are not allowed. For males the length of the hair may not fall below the base of a collared shirt. Students circumventing the hair rules must be in compliance 100% of the time at school and at all school functions.
13. Any article of clothing with suggestive symbols, words or advertisements of products or substances prohibited by St. Tammany Board policy shall be prohibited. Sexual innuendos are strictly forbidden.
