

Mandeville High Senior Trip Guidelines

This year's Senior Trip will include visits to the Disney and Universal theme parks in Orlando, Florida. We depart on the evening of Wednesday, April 11th and return the morning of Sunday, April 15th. All Mandeville High, St. Tammany Parish, and Disney/Universal rules and regulations are in effect throughout the duration of the trip. Additionally, we will be enforcing the following guidelines:

- Students must be classified as a graduating senior for the spring semester in order to be eligible for the trip.
- Students who do not attend daily classes at MHS, such as those classified as "Hospital/Homebound", are not permitted to participate.
- Students who have received an out-of-school suspension during the current school year will not be permitted to attend the trip.
- Any student who is under judicial order and/or probation is not permitted to participate.
- The student and at least one parent must attend the **mandatory** Disney meeting on Tuesday, February 27th at 7 pm in the auditorium.
- A notarized permission slip and a copy of the student's medical insurance card are required for this trip. We will have notaries available at school from 5-7 pm on January 30th for your convenience at a reduced price of \$5.
- Students are required to complete all seat time obligations prior to the day of departure for the trip.
- Students must be on track to meet the minimum graduation requirements in order to attend the trip. Any student in danger of not graduating or who receives an out-of-school suspension will NOT receive a refund after December 19th.
- Any student involved in a serious disciplinary offense while on the trip, including use of drugs/alcohol, will be sent home at their own expense.
- Any student sent home from the Senior Trip will forfeit his/her right to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- Payments must be current, including fundraiser balances, in order to attend this trip. Do NOT drop off payments to Student Services, the office, or Mr. Esker's box. **Give trip payments directly to Mr. Esker in Guidance at lunch.** Give fundraiser payments to Ms. Dean in room 406.

Payment schedule (Mr. Esker): Initial payment - \$250 by September 22nd
\$225 by October 27th
(December 19th is last day for refund) \$225 by December 15th

MHS SENIOR TRIP 2018
PERMISSION FORM

My **son/daughter**, _____, has my permission to attend the school-sponsored senior trip to Orlando, Florida, from Wednesday night, April 11th through Sunday, April 15th. I understand that my child is responsible for adhering to the rules and regulations of Mandeville High School and the St. Tammany Parish School Board. I also understand that **he/she** will be under the care and supervision of the administrators and chaperones from Mandeville High School.

I hereby release the administrators and chaperones, and the St. Tammany Parish School Board of liability to the extent whereby it can be proven in a properly convened court of law that any or all of the aforementioned are not negligent in the event of bodily injury.

The administrators and chaperones **have/do not have** my permission to give my child over-the-counter medications such as Advil, Tylenol, Benadryl or antacids, if necessary. I also **give/do not give** the administrators and chaperones permission to seek emergency medical care for my child, if necessary.

I understand that if my child does not abide by the rules or commits any serious violation, I will be notified by telephone, and my child will be sent home on the next available mode of transportation at my cost and will forfeit **his/her** right to participate in the graduation ceremony.

I understand that my child must have no outstanding balances at the time of the trip. I also understand that both my child and I must attend a mandatory informational meeting to discuss rules and procedures of the trip. **He/She** must be passing all required classes (including online and independent studies) and in position to meet the minimum graduation requirements before being allowed to attend the trip. **Refunds will NOT be issued after December 19, 2017, regardless of the circumstances.**
