We are very excited that you have expressed an interest in becoming a member of the MHS Spinnakers and/or Mariners dance teams for the 2023-2024 school year. Spinnakers is a varsity team comprised of MHS students in grades 9-12. Mariners is a junior varsity team comprised of students in grades 9-10. If you are selected for either team, there are certain personal and financial responsibilities and obligations which you and your parents must assume in order to qualify as a member in good standing. Please read this information carefully with your parents before you decide to try out. In order to try out, both parent/guardian and dancer must be present at a **mandatory informational meeting** on **Wednesday**, **February 8th at 5:30pm** in the MHS Library. Membership is a *yearlong* commitment and begins this spring with a **mandatory parent meeting and fitting** for both teams on **Tuesday**, **March 14th**.

Teams will begin practicing in the spring on Mondays (Mariners), Tuesdays (Spinnakers), and Thursdays (both) to prepare for UDA camp. Additional practices may be scheduled to prepare for UDA camp. UDA camp is MANDATORY for both teams. Please see the dates listed above. If you cannot attend UDA camp, please do not try out. You will be dismissed from the team. There will

also be a fundraiser camp that both teams must attend at MHS. If you cannot attend, you will receive demerits.

Starting in August, practices for both teams will be on Mondays (Mariners), Tuesdays (Spinnakers), and Thursdays (both) from 2:40pm – 4:30pm. Practice will go until 5:00 in January to prepare for competition. Off-campus technique practices for Mariners will be held on Mondays. Technique for Spinnakers will be held on Wednesdays starting in August. It will be hosted at a local studio, and payments will be made directly to the host.

For Spinnakers, Monday practices will be added in the fall as competition season approaches, and weekend practices will be scheduled as needed. Weekly ballet class is strongly encouraged for all dancers. This class may be taken at the dance studio of their choice. Although students are encouraged to be active within the MHS community, dancers will not be able to participate in any sport or extracurricular with a conflicting time schedule.

Candidate Requirements:

- Candidates must have a clean discipline record and a 2.0 grade point average with no semester failing grades.
- All candidates trying out must presently be a student of MHS, or an incoming ninth grader from any MHS feeder school, except for those transferring from other schools. Transferring students need documentation confirming proof of residency within MHS's district.
- If selected to be a Spinnaker or Mariner, the student MUST have a **physical signed by a doctor** before the team leaves for camp in the summer.

- A candidate <u>must not owe</u> any fines or fees to Mandeville High School, the Spinnakers, the Mariners, or to any club, team or other organization at MHS or their own school.
- Each candidate will receive a copy of the <u>MHS Spinnakers & Mariners Constitution</u> (rules) which must be signed by the student and parent/guardian before tryouts. Constitutions will be distributed at the parent/dancer pre-tryout meeting. Dance team members are expected to meet high standards of conduct and academics.

Candidates must attend all days of the tryout clinic, submit all paperwork on time, and pay the tryout fee of \$20 to be eligible for tryouts.

Tryout apparel:

Plain black leotard, black skirt, shorts, hot shorts or skirt, jazz shoes, hair in bun off of face and performance makeup on day of try-outs. Flesh colored tights are optional.

*No jewelry, tennis shoes, black soled shoes, hair down or bright colored sports bras**

Tryout evaluations include:

Turns – chaînes, piques, attitude, double & triple pirouettes, à la secondes (leg second), Coupé **Jumps/leaps** – jeté, second leap, calypso, toe touch, turning disc **Misc**. – straight, fan & pitch kicks, splits

*Please note: these skills are not mandatory to make the teams; however, each team will perform routines including these throughout the year.

Tryout process:

Judges are independently hired professionals who will evaluate participants and record their scores. These scores will be added to teacher recommendation scores to calculate total points. If a dancer has less than 7 teacher recommendations, 0s will be added in place of the missing recommendations to calculate the score. Candidates may have more than 7 recommendations.

Candidates will be identified by a number given out at the clinic. Judges will score candidates anonymously by their audition number. The top 70% of each team will consist solely of judges' scores. The remaining 30% of each team will be selected based upon judges' scores and how the dancers fit in with the abilities of the top 70%.

Candidates will be scored on game day, jazz, pom and hip-hop technique, as well as leaps, turns, and kicks. Call backs will be utilized as needed.

Both teams will have welcome parties (dates listed above). Members are expected to attend, and parents are invited to join!

Dance team tryout clinic and tryouts are closed to all spectators.

Parents and spectators must remain outside until tryouts are concluded.

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY:

The *estimated* financial obligation to be a member of the Spinnakers team is \$2,000.00*. The *estimated* financial obligation to be a member of the Mariners team is \$1,600.00*. This amount covers the cost of all uniforms, camp, and accessories but *does not* include regional & national competition fees due in <u>December.</u> Competition is optional for Spinnakers and for Mariners. <u>Estimated cost for Spinnakers state & national competition will be approximately \$2,500.00* per girl. Estimated competition cost for Mariners state competitions are \$500* per girl; however, there will be ample opportunity to fundraise throughout the year.</u>
